Now comes Mary Ann Jinks  
Plaintiff in the above entitled case and humbly  
complaining of said John Nelson Jinks Defendant  
therein respectfully represents unto your Honor that  
said Plaintiff and Defendant are residents of said Weber  
County and that they were legally married to each other  
on the first day of April A. D. 1860; That there are as  
the fruits of said marriage four children, to wit: Wal-  
lace Jinks ten years old past, Chauncey Jinks eight  
years old past, Lucinda Jinks four years old past,

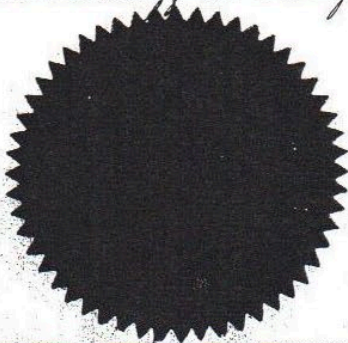
