 come to the hands and Possession of the s. Hannah and James or into  
 the hands and Possession of any other Person or Persons for them do well and truly  
 Administer according to the said Will and the same do make a true and  
 perfect copy of the same and deliver the same to the Reg. Court at Chester

 Chattels & Credits which shall be found remaining upon the s. Adm. also: the same

 shall deliver and pay to such Person & Persons respectively as the s. Court by its order  
 or Sentence pursuant to Law shall direct and Appoint, and if it shall hereafter appear  
 that any last Will and Testament was made by the decd. and the Executor or Administrators  
 the within named do Exhibitt the same into the Reg. Office at Chester. upon Request to  
 have the same Allowed & approved of Accord. by the s. Hannah and James  
 Admin. Approb. of such Testam. being first had & made at s. office. then by or the Reg.
