Family of George Harrison of Westmoreland County, Virginia

George Harrison of Cople Parish lived in the eastern end of Westmoreland County near Richmond and Northumberland Counties. The land of at least one of George Harrison's neighbors lay on both sides of the Westmoreland-Richmond County Line. George Harrison's home was in Yeocomico forest between the heads of three major watercourses: Yeocomico and Nomini Rivers in Westmoreland County and Totuskey Creek in Richmond County. The amount of land was about 454 acres as mentioned in his Will of 2 October 1713.
