KNOW ALL MEN TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME:

THAT William Johnson having served faithfully and honorably for the term of Fourteen months from the Fifth day of December until the thirtieth day of December, and being honorably discharged from the Army of Texas is entitled to twelve hundred eighty Acres Bounty Land, for which this is his Certificate.

And the said William Johnson is entitled to hold said Land, or to sell, alienate, convey and donate the same, and to exercise all rights of ownership over it.

This Certificate will be transferable by Exchange, with a Deed, before any competent Authority, with Witnesses to the same.
