THAT William Johnson having served faithfully and honorably for the term of thirteen months from the fifteenth day of October until the fourth day of December

and being honorably discharged from the Army of Texas is entitled to twelve hundred and eighty Acres Bounty Land, for which this is his Certificate.

And the said William Johnson is entitled to hold said Land, or to sell, alienate, convey and donate the same, and to exercise all rights of ownership over it.

This Certificate will be authenticable by Endorsement, with a Deed, before any competent Authority, with Witnesses to the same.

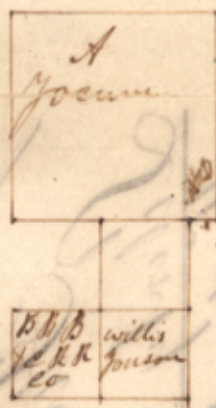
