

This Indenture, Made the second day of April in the  
Year one thousand eight hundred and twenty two Between  
Garret Schuyler of the Town of Minisink County of Orange & State  
of New York and Mary his wife of the first part, and William B.  
Stoddard of the Town County and State aforesaid of the second  
part. Witnesseth, that the said parties of the first part, for and in  
consideration of the sum of Seventeen hundred Dollars lawful money  
of the United States, to them in hand paid by the said party of the  
second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have  
granted, bargained, sold, aliened, released and confirmed and  
by these presents doth grant, bargain sell, alien release and con-  
firm unto the said party of the second part, and to his heirs and

apigus for ever. All those two certain Lots pieces & parcels of Land situate in the said Town of Minisink the first being Lot number ten of the Town Lots laid out to the right of the Town of Goshen Bounds as follows. Beginning at a Stake & Stones marked number ten & the north corner of Lot number nine in the line of the Jersey Claim and runs from thence North forty six Degrees West Twenty chains and twenty one Links to Lot number eleven then along said Lot South forty four Degrees West thirty one chains & fifty Links to the middle line of said tract then South forty six degrees East Twenty chains & fifty one Links to Lot number nine then along said Lot North forty four degrees East thirty one chains & fifty Links to the place of Beginning containing sixty five & a half acres of Land. The other Lot is bounded as follows to wit. Beginning at a Stone marked XVIII and running from thence South forty six degrees & Twenty seven minutes East Twenty chain along the lands of Peter Luck to the line of the above mentioned Lot then South forty three Degrees & thirty three minutes West thirty chains and Twenty Links along the said above mentioned Lot and the lands of John Milligan three North forty seven Degrees & forty three minutes West nine ten chains and fifty eight Links three North forty two Degrees East thirty chains & Sixty Links to the place of Beginning containing Sixty acres and Twenty three Rods of Land in the same more or less the two lots being all the lands John Milligan formerly owned in the Town of Minisink aforesaid together with all and singular the rights, members, inhabitants and appurtenances unto the said premises in any wise pertaining or belonging; And the reversion and reversions, remainders and annuities, rents, issues and profits thereof; And Also all the estate right, title, interest, property, claim and demand whatsoever as well in Law as in equity of the said parties of the first part, of, in, and to the same, and every part and parcel thereof, with the appurtenances to have and to hold the above granted, bargained and described premises, with the appurtenances, unto the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, for their own proper use, benefit and behoof for ever. And the said parties of the first part, for themselves and their heirs, executors and administrators, Doth covenant, promise, grant and agree to and with the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns, that they the said parties of the first part their heirs and assigns, the said lot, piece or parcel of Land above described and hereby granted and conveyed, and every part and parcel thereof, with the appurtenances, unto the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns, against the said parties of the first part, their heirs and assigns, and all and every other person or persons whomever shall and will warrant and forum defend In witness whereof, the parties to these presents have hereunto interchangably set their hands and seals the day and year first above written —
