this the sixth day of December, 1842.

Condition Whereas the above bound Alfred Johnson
hath this day obtained Letters Temporary of Adm
inistration of the said John A. Dillard Deputy
Clerk as aforesaid, to collect and take care of the
goods, chattles and effects of Snelling Johnson deceased.
Now if the said Alfred Johnson, shall take into
his possession the goods, chattles and effects of said
deceased, and keep the same without impoverishment
or waste until legal administration thereunto shall
be granted, then this obligation to be void, otherwise
to remain in full force, power and virtue.

Hundred and Forty two.
