do hereby make this Present writing my last <sup>will</sup> &

together with my funeral Expences be paid by my Exe-  
cutors as soon as conveniently can be by my Executors after  
my decease

Item. I give & bequeath my son William Wollerton the  
the Sum of Fifty four Pounds to be paid to him in one  
year after my decease by my Executors

Item. I give & bequeath to my son Ziba Wollerton the  
Sum of Twenty four Pounds to be paid to him in one  
year after my decease by my Executors

Item. I give & bequeath to my son James Wollerton  
the Sum of Thirty four Pounds to be paid to him in one  
year after my decease by my Executors

Item. I give & bequeath to my son John Wollerton the sum  
of Twenty four Pounds to be paid to him in one year after  
my decease by my Executors

Item. I give & bequeath to my four Daughters & Daugh-  
ter-in-law namely Susannah Price Jane Gray Zeruiah Ruth  
Sidney Wollerton & Rebekah Wollerton all my ~~clothes~~ to  
be Equally divided amongst them share & Share alike  
& to my daughter Sidney I likewise give one New blue & white  
Coverlid not yet made

All the Residue & Remainder of my Estate is to be Equally  
divided amongst my four Sons share & share alike namely  
William Wollerton Ziba Wollerton James Wollerton & John  
Wollerton

Lastly I Constitute & Appoint my Brother in Law  
James Wollerton & my son William Wollerton to be my  
Executors of this my last will & Testament. In Witness
