ANCESTOR'S SERVICE

"Section 2. Any man shall be eligible to membership in the Society who, being of the age of eighteen years or over, and a citizen of good character, in the United States, or of any state or territory where he has resided for at least one year, and, if a native, or naturalized man, in the armed forces of the Continental Congress, or of any one of the several Colonies or States, as a signer of the Declaration of Independence; or as a member of a Committee of Safety or Correspondence; or as a member of any Continental, Provincial, or Colonial Congresses or Legislatures; or as a recognized patriot who performed ardent service by overt acts of resistance to the authority of Great Britain."—Constitution of National Society S. A. R., article IV, Section 2, adopted June 5, 1907, and as amended.

Membership is based upon one original claim; when the applicant derives eligibility by descent from more than one Revolutionary ancestor, and it is desired to file additional claims, separate applications, to be marked "Supplemental Applications," should be made in such case and filed with the original.

By order of the Board of Trustees, May 3, 1911, the recipient of a certificate granted on this application agrees to surrender his certificate upon failure to pay his membership dues, unless his membership shall cease by reason of death or actual disability, to be determined by the Society of which he is a member.

Young, John, Hopkinton. List of 6 months men raised agreeable to Resolve of June 5, 1780, dated, Springfield. Engaged for the town of Hopkinton to begin July 1, 1780 under command of Captain Dix; his name appears on the pay roll, discharged Dec., 15, 1780; service, 5 mos. 22 days, travel (200 miles) included. He is described as being 17 years of age; stature 5 feet, 3 inches; complexion, light.
