

Letter written to Bessie from
Mother Jan. 9, 1942

Greenville, Utah.
Jan 9 1942.

Dearest Bessie: Before I forget. don't you know it is 1942. you had 1941. well I have surely been worried about you. here it is Sunday the 9. and just getting a letter from you. and it was misssent to Beaver. I kept after your dad to write but you know how easy going he is. then when we got this one this morning he took it all over town and I had to go get it.

Know Bessie. there was a letter came Sunday from Vivian and I put the add. you gave us. on it 661. then Monday the pictures came \$2.00 I sent a card. on Monday. to tell you then your dad sent a letter from the Government to you he thought it might be some thing about Vivian's insurance. If you haven't received then go right away to the post office and ask about them. My arm and hand hurts so bad. I cannot write.

I am in for it now I have Glenma Rae on my lap and she is just having one time I will try and finish. Glenma is a sleep and I want to clean the front room and bedroom on saturday.

did Vivian tell you that they were seperated Ralph and Roy are together. Jewel and Vivian. King is in another place I think Frank.

told me for mis Beaver. well with King. Ralph said that if real action or if they had to sail they would be out back to gather. Byron B is

in another place. also.

yes. Grandma and Grandpa are back.

Poss. hasn't found his suit case yet.

I got 2.50 for my milk today. and I have two more sending that I will get on the 20th of the month so I want to get something nice that I can keep.

I talk to Mr. Steffen this morning. I told him I wanted you to call him and see about the 4 # club pins and money. and he said he was coming to Logan next week. and he would look you up. I gave him your add. as Mrs. Bessie Edwards and after it thought maybe I should of told him Fordham.

I want your dad to see if he will bring you a box of fruit up. Grandpa and Grandma said they want to send you a bottle of corn bean and out of jelly. well Bessie I cannot send a box this Thursday or Friday because I just got your letter and I will need to mix bread to morrow so if I can I will send one Sunday or Monday for sure. Bessie your room mate sure look like Vir. Williams.

and the other one looks like the one that works in the drug store. the one I was telling you how Howard was talking to. I am sure glad you got to stay with them.

I'll say Glenna miss you and she is not the only one. I don't know how I am going to manage. I just have to carry her around. and I can't work with her in my arms. But she is worth it we haven't heard from Howard since we were making matters. Bessie I will pay 1/3 of this 2.00 shall I open and take mine out or shall I just send them to you and then you can send me one back. I hope you got your mail O.K. write or if you are sociable. Mother.
