BENJAMIN MARTINO, yeoman, Castletown,-- my wife, HANNAH MARTINO, shall have the use of my estate until my daughter, Elizabeth, shall be of legal age, at which time my executors shall divide my farm as follows:- to run a line across the same beginning at the highway leading to Halliker's Mill to Vincent Bodine's tavern, so as to intersect a craggy rock in the orchard about sixty yards from the southernmost part and running parallel to the fence to the land of Peter LaForge.

All that part, I give to my daughter, Elizabeth, who shall give to my wife a bond for \$250; also two cows, bed and bedding six Windsor chairs; six silver teaspoons marked with the first letters of my and my wife's names B H .

I give to my son, Gabriel Martino, all the northern part of my farm from the line as drawn with the buildings thereon, cows, horses, my silver shoe buckles, stock buckles, and knee buckles, chest etc. and he shall when he arrives at legal age give my wife a bond for \$500. My wife shall have negro boy Tom until he be of age and free by law.

My salt meadow shall be divided between the two children, Elizabeth the north part and Gabriel the south.

Executors- wife, Hannah, John Bodine, son of Vincent; and Richard Conner.

JOSEPH LAKE, yeoman, -- to my wife, (ELIZABETH) one cow, bed, bedding etc; she may remain, until she dies or marries, in possession of the land and the house. If she marry she shall have 50 pounds. The remainder shall be sold and divided among my five children.

Executors- nephew, Joshua Mercereau and wife, Jan.20,1815, Elizabeth Lake, wid.renounced.
