The Eleventh Day of the Ninth Month, in the Year of our Lord one Thousand Seven Hundred & Seventy Three, I Charles Wollerton of the Township of East Bradford in the County of Chester, in the Province of Pennsylvania, being aged and weak of Body, but of perfect Mind & Memory, thanks be given to God therefore, calling to mind the uncertainty of time here, Do make and Ordain this my last Will & Testament, in manner and form following:—

Item, It is my Will and I do order that all my just Debts and funeral Charges be fully paid & Satisfied,

Item I Give Devise & Bequeath unto my Son John Wollerton and to his Heirs and Assigns forever, All that part of my Land in East Bradford aforesaid that lies on the West Side of a certain Line I have now fixed, which line begins at a Post Seventy one perches from John Grays Chestnut Corner tree, betwix y^e South and West in y^e line between my Land & y^e said y^r. Grays, and from the said Post to run a Course South Twenty Nine Degrees East quite through my Tract into y^e Road leading to Tho. Spashmans Mill, all y^e land on y^e West side of said Course (nearly where y^e partition fence now stands) be it more or less, to be my Son y^r. part of my Land &c

Item I Give & Bequeath unto the children of my Daughter Sarah Finley Deceased the Sum of five shillings to be Divided amongst them

I Give & Bequeath to my Daughter Mary Jellie y^e Sum of five shillings
I Give & Bequeath to my Daughter Jane y^e Sum of five shillings

Item I Give Devise and Bequeath unto my Son James Wollerton, all and singular the remaining part of my Tract of Land where I now live, which lies to the East of the aforesaid partition Line, which I have now fixed, with all the Buildings and Improvements thereon the same, and to his Heirs and Assigns for ever, and I also Give to my said Son James Wollerton all the Reversion and Remainder of my Estate both Real & Personal, he paying y^e said above Legacies &c

Lastly I do hereby constitute Ordain and Nominate my Son James Wollerton my only whole & sole Executor of this my last Will and Testament, hereby Disannulling Revoaking and utterly making Void all other and former Wills and Testaments by me heretofore made, Ratifying and Confirming this and no other to be my last Will and Testament; In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my Hand & Seal the Day and Year first above Written.
