Simon Stevens

Born 6 May 1748 in Enmore, Sommerset County, England
Married 15 Nov 1770 to Mary Kidner, born 1748 in Enmore. He died 21 Oct 1821, she died in May 1829, both buried at Enmore.

Thomas Stevens

Born and chr. 4 Jan 1789 at Enmore, Sommerset County England. Married at Cannington 3 March 1819 to Ann Locke, born and chr. 23 Dec 1798 at Cannington.

Children - all born at Bridgewater

- *1. William Stevens b. 23 Dec 1819 chr. 16 Jan 1820 at Bridgewater, Sommerset County, England. Married to Emma Crowden Stevens (she was the widow of Joseph Stevens, older cousin(?) of William, who died two years after his marriage of pneumonia). Both marriages took place at the Trinity Church in Bridgewater. William and Emma died at Oakley, Utah in 1901, he in March and she in December.

Born 23 Dec 1819 at Bridgewater, Sommerset, England.
Married Emma Crowden Stevens on 17 June 1845 at
Bridgewater Trinity Church. William died March 1901,
Emma died December 1901.

Children

1. Sarah Ann Stevens b. and chr. 24 Nov 1847 at Durleigh, Sommerset, England. Married Hyrum Moroni Mechem on 24 Nov 1865 at Wanship, Utah. Their only child I knew was Isabel Mechem who married Louis Jensen and lived in Oakley. Sarah died 3 Jan 1886, I think in Roosevelt or Vernal.
- *2. William Henry Stevens b. and chr. 13 Sept 1849 at Durleigh, Smmst. England. Married Eliza Alice Maria Hortin on 1 Jan 1870 at Wanship, Utah. They had both come from England about the same time and came to Utah with the same wagon company. Both of their families settled in the adjoining towns of Rockport and Wanship in Summit County. Both died in Salt Lake City, but were buried in Oakley. He died 7 Nov 1913, and she died 7 July 1926.
3. Ellen Christiana Stevens b. 29 Dec 1851 at Enmore, Smmst. England. Married John Austin Neal (Neel). They had five or six sons, and he died when they were quite young. They left Oakley as they grew up, some went to Canada. I remember Aunt Ellen living in a small house east of Seymour's old home and north of the old church. In her sixties, she seemed very old to us and was a very small person. Alice, Gladys, Iris and I went up and stayed with her at our mother's insistence because she was sickly and alone. She finally left Oakley to live in Salt Lake and died 3 April 1927.
4. Simon Percival Stevens b. 7 Jan 1854 at Enmore, Smmst. England. Died 19 Dec 1898. He never married. Dad called him Uncle Percy. He was the first one to be buried in the Stevens cemetery.
5. Emaline Augusta Stevens b. 27 Feb 1856 at Enmore, Smmst. England. Married Daniel Bigelow, moved out of Oakley. Lived in Salt Lake for awhile, called Aunt Gus. Died 25 Feb 1918.
6. Theophilus Franklin Stevens b. 27 June 1860, just before his family crossed the Platte River on their way to Utah. Birth was registered in Wanship. He died 30 May 1879 and was buried at Wanship.
7. Isaac Thomas Stevens b. 13 Jan 1863 at Wanship. Married Emma Wooley, she died soon after their youngest child was born. Uncle Tom lived in Oakley all his life, and being Grandpa's youngest brother seemed more like our uncle than Dad's. We older children knew and loved him for the kind, pleasant uncle who lived down the road across the Weber River. His children were dear

to us and visited Mother and Dad often - Hazel Stevens (Marchant) and Elva Stevens (Vernon) raised the other children after their mother's death. The others were Herbert, Milton and Alton (my age) who died when he was about five.
8. Abigail Charlotte Stevens b. 9 Nov 1865 in Wanship. Married Charles Pierce Watterson. Died 19 Oct 1903. She lived in Salt Lake and later in California. Called Aunt Abby by Dad. One of her descendants is buried in the Stevens cemetery in Oakley.

William Henry Stevens Born 16 Sept 1849 at Bridgewater, Somerset, England. Married Eliza Alice Maria Hortin 1 Jan 1870 at Wanship. Eliza was born 9 July 1848 at Lemington, Warwick County, England. He died 7 Nov 1926, and she died 2 July 1926, both in Salt Lake City. Both are buried in Oakley.

1. Horace Henry Stevens b. 29 Nov 1870 in Wanship, Summit County, Utah. Married Emma Hoyt 3 June 1902 at Marion, Utah. Died 8 Jan 1940 in Salt Lake City, buried at Oakley. Emma H. Stevens died 15 Nov 1967, also buried at Oakley.
2. George Geroy Stevens b. 22 Sept 1873 in Wanship, Utah. Married Clara Ellen Wilkins in 1896. She died in 1922, and he married Catherine _____ in 1922. He died 22 Sept 1947.
3. Mary Maude Stevens b. 9 Oct 1875. Did not marry. Died in Salt Lake City 8 Jan 1922.
4. Clarice Laurette Stevens b. 11 Nov 1877. Married Earnest Pack (Uncle Chunk). They lived in Kamas. She died 21 Dec 1959.
5. William Ward Stevens b. 11 Jan 1880 at Wanship. Married Mayme Stembridge. He died due to an infection caused by an arm being severed in a saw mill at age 26, 13 Jan 1906.
6. Edith Stevens b. 10 Oct 1881 at Oakley. Married Robert Pack. Died 21 Jan 1966
7. Laura Emmabell b. 29 Nov 1883 at Oakley. Married Jack Thomas in 1926, died 24 May 1928 in Salt Lake.
8. Nettie Jane Stevens b. 21 July 1885 at Oakley. Married Clyde Austin Hall. Died 24 July 1963
9. Hattie Leone Stevens b. 5 June 1888 at Oakley. Did not marry. Died in Salt Lake City.

10. Roscoe Reed Stevens b. 7 Sept 1890 at Oakley.
Married Sarah Myrtle Jones 28 Jan 1913.
Died 24 June 1949.
11. Leland Hortin Stevens b. 20 Mar 1893. Married
Myrtle Ann Tuttle Crawford on 29 Oct 1913. She
died 30 Dec 1946. He later married Elizabeth
Evans Jones. He died 25 Oct 1954.
