B. James Charles (Nov. 5, 1827-1910) Born in Pendleton County, W. Va. Lived in Ottobine and Mt. Clinton, Va. Served briefly in Confederate Army, farmer, Superintendent of Valley Turnpike (now U.S.11), built Rawley Springs Hotel. Mennonite and later Presbyterian. Buried beside second wife in Mt. Clinton Mennonite Church Cemetery. <sup>my fourth</sup> Possibly 16 children. Married Christina Good (Sept. 2, 1827-Sept. 26, 1862) on Oct. 18, 1849. Her mother was a Diller from Pennsylvania. She is buried in Bank Mennonite Cemetery. They had six children: Margaret Susan, Christina, Peter, Elizabeth "Betty", James B., and John William. Second marriage to Anna Magdalene Funk (1838-1899). She was descended from Bishop Henry Funk who came to Pennsylvania in 1719. He was the first Mennonite Bishop in America. His son, Henry, left Pa. in the Revolution and came to the Valley in 1786. He was a "Friend of the Revolution" according to Pa. archives (basis for DAR membership). His son was Joseph; Joseph's son was Christian; Christian's son was also Christian (1812- ) the father of Anna Magdalene. Christian, Anna's father, lived at Turleytown. He married Franey Brenneman, Sept. 3, 1833, in Rushville, Va. Franey is buried in Edom Cemetery (Va.) Further information on Anna Magdalene may be found in Funk and Geil family histories.
