1780	Elizabeth Pittaway daughter of Edward and Jane Pittaway is baptized in Solihull, Warwickshire, England on the 7th of January
1799	Elizabeth Pittaway married John Bird at Saint Martin in the Bull Ring, Birmingham, Warwickshire, England on the 15th of October, William Bird and William Laynes were witnesses
1800	Elizabeth Bird and John Bird witnessed the marriage of William Bird to Mariah Goddard on the 13th of October at Saint Martin in the Bull Ring, Birmingham, Warwickshire, England.
1801	Jane Bird daughter of John and Elizabeth Bird was baptized the 20th of April in Solihull, Warwickshire, England
1802	Maria Bird daughter of John and Elizabeth Bird was baptized the 4th of January in Solihull, Warwickshire, England
1805	Jane Bird daughter of John and Elizabeth Bird was buried the 13th of September in Solihull, Warwickshire, England
1806	John Bird son of John and Elizabeth Bird was baptized the 12th of January in Solihull, Warwickshire, England
1808	Hannah Bird daughter of John and Elizabeth Bird was baptized the 24th of April in Solihull, Warwickshire, England
1810	Elizabeth Bird daughter of John and Elizabeth Bird was baptized the 26th of March in Solihull, Warwickshire, England
1812	George Bird son of John and Elizabeth Bird was baptized the 24th of February at Saint Martin in the Bull Ring, Birmingham, Warwickshire, England
1821	Thomas Bird son of Maria Bird of Beggarly Green was baptized on the 15th of June in Solihull, Warwickshire, England. Elizabeth Bird is not named but this is further documentation of the Bird family in Beggarly Green, Solihull, Warwickshire, England
1821	Maria Bird married William Jakeman at Saint Martin in the Bull Ring, Birmingham, Warwickshire, England on the 2nd of October, Elizabeth Bird was a witness to the marriage
1823	Elizabeth Bird was buried in Solihull, Warwickshire, England on the 6th of April. She was 13 years of age and lived in Beggarly Green.
1827	Hannah Bird married William Clark(e) at Saint Martin in the Bull Ring, Birmingham, Warwickshire, England on the 26th of December, Elizabeth Bird was a witness to the marriage
1830	John Bird married Ann Russton (Russon) at Saint Martin in the Bull Ring, Birmingham, Warwickshire, England on the 10th of May, witnesses were William Hyde and Pheobe Russon. Elizabeth Bird is not mentioned but this is our family line.

1833	John Bird of Olten End was buried the 25th of December in Solihull, Warwickshire, England.
1836	Elizabeth Bird, widow married Thomas Berry, widower were married at Aston Juxta Birminingham, Warwickshire, England. Hannah Clarke and John Bird were witnesses to the marriage
1840	Elizabeth Berry was in attendance at the death of her granddaughter Mary Ann Clarke on the 5th of December in Solihull, Warwickshire, England at Overly Green. (Death Certificate of Mary Ann Clarke names her as the daughter of William Clarke, Mary Ann Clark daughter of William and Hannah Clark was baptized the 5th of October in Solihull, Warwickshire, England
1841	National Census for Solihull, Warwickshire, England Thomas Berry age 60 and Elizabeth Berry age 60 were enumerated as living in Beggarly Green.
1847	Thomas Berry of Overly was buried on the 20th of August age 68 in Solihull, Warwickshire, England
1848	Elizabeth Berry widow age 60 daughter of Edward Pittaway and Thomas Williams age 50 bachelor were married the 5th of June at Saint Martin in the Bull Ring, Birmingham, Warwickshire, England
1851	National Census Birmingham, Warwickshire, England All Saints parish Thomas Williams age 54 born in Solihull, Warwickshire, England with wife Elizabeth Williams age 72 born in Solihull, Warwickshire, England. John Clark age 21 was living with them named as nephew. John Clark was listed as being born in Solihull, Warwickshire, England. There was a John Clarke baptized at Solihull in 1830 who was the son of William Clarke and Hannah. There is no proof this is the same person. Thomas Williams was enumerated next door to George Bird in All Saints parish.
	Neither Thomas nor Elizabeth Williams were enumerated on the 1861 census and it is believed they had died
