THE PETITION of the above-named petitioner alleges:

That your petitioner resides at No. *134 Vernon Avenue*  
in the Borough of Brooklyn, City of New York, and is *the widow*  
of the said *Jacob Grossman* deceased, and  
is of full age.

That said deceased died at the County of Kings, on the *24<sup>th</sup>* day of *September* 191*4*,
